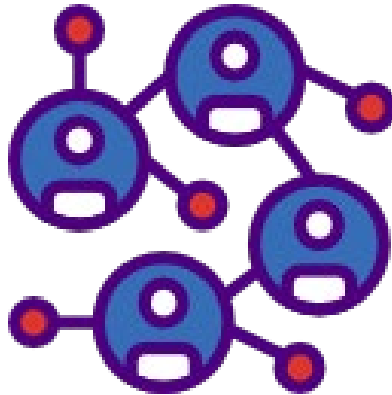

Eligibility and Application Requirements

Be available for Spring W2W, Pre-Term training and programming (Dates TBD), and be on campus in the Fall**



You **cannot** be concurrently applying to the Leadership Fellow program



You **cannot** be on academic probation. GPA less than 2.67 for the semester.

Frequently asked questions

Is this a paid position?

Yes, you will not only get paid in swag, but, SLFs will also get paid in 3 installments throughout the school year.

Will this interfere with my summer internship?

OSL works with Career Management to send a letter to your internship employer to notify them of the SLF position and its responsibilities. It's your responsibility to speak to your employer and discuss when you have to return to campus for Pre-Term.

What is the time commitment?

Apart from required trainings and events, you make your own schedule for SLF fam community building and outreach throughout the academic year.
